Extensive research went into choosing an electronic voting program. In 2015, the AFA brought Election-buddy onto our campus for our contract ratification vote. Their clients include Yale University, Harvard University, SUNY Downstate Medical, University of Maryland and many other organizations and corporations. Unique voter keys are used to cast votes.

Once an individual votes, that key is then "spent" and can no longer be used. This method completely prevents individuals from attempting to vote using computers linked to different IP addresses, or attempting to use masked virtual browsers. The votes are automatically tabulated by Electionbuddy and they disseminate the results. The platform uses 256-bit encryption, which is the same security used at major banks. For these reasons, Electionbuddy was chosen as a voting platform that is unable to be tampered with and provides accurate voting results.

As in all AFA elections, integrity and transparency are our goals. On September 24th, 2016, every adjunct was notified of whether or not they were a member of the electorate for our 2016 elections. Any adjuncts who were not a part of the electorate, due to their employment not meeting the criteria outlined in our constitution, including administrators, agency fee payers, and those in arrears with their dues payments, were notified of such. This gave individuals ample time to take the steps necessary to become a member of the voting pool. Adjuncts who met the employment criteria and became members and/or paid their arrears were added to the voting pool up until 6:00PM on the evening prior to the opening of the election. In all, 1,165 adjuncts, eligible to vote, were sent ballots. A total of five adjuncts questioned why they did not receive a ballot; four were told that they were agency fee payers and one that they were in arrears with dues payment. This indicated that we achieved 100% accuracy in determining the voting pool.

Rose Tavitian serves as the AFA Elections Chair. When Rose decided to run for the Secretary position, she immediately recused herself from any involvement in the Officer election. The AFA Executive Board, in a unanimous vote, appointed Mike Zartler to be the Interim Elections Chair for the Officers Election of 2016. Because Rose has full access to the Electionbuddy module, as a result of her running the Department Representative elections, Michael was instructed to set up a completely separate Electionbuddy account. Michael used this second Electionbuddy account to conduct the Officer elections, to which Rose had no access.

All candidates were invited to the AFA Conference room on November 1st, 2016 to view the opening of the results. Prior to the opening of any results, those in attendance were given the election rules as to what should happen in the event of a tie and that our elections are based on plurality voting. All candidates were asked if they had any questions about the election process; no one had a question or voiced a concern about the process.

There were no candidates for the DR positions in English and Africana Studies. AFA members in those departments were notified of a special election that is currently underway.






Results: Allied Health Sciences






Results: Engineering/Physics/Technology

Results: History/Political Science/ Geography






Results: Hospitality Business

Results: Health/Physical Education and Recreation


